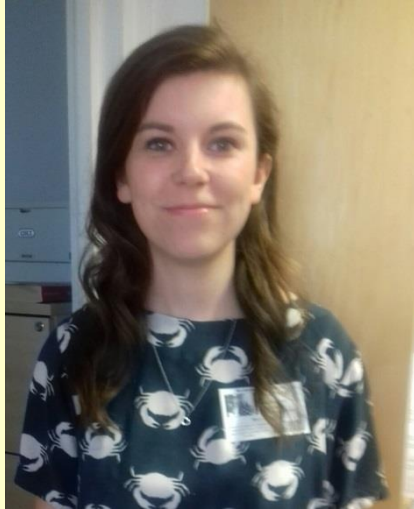

Weekly PE sessions

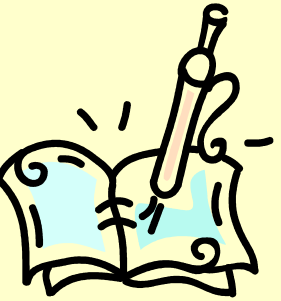
PE will take place on Thursday and Friday mornings.

How can you help your child at home?

- ✓ Talk to them about their day
- ✓ Continue to read with your child every day – read to them and let them read to you. Talk about what they have read – ask lots of questions, specific and general
- ✓ Help them to learn their spellings ‘look, cover, write, check’ method



- Keep them healthy – early bed times, limit TV, healthy food, exercise
