Kit

- Children must arrive with a packed bag/small suitcase with all the items included on the kit list we have provided you with.
- We ask that children **do not** bring any electrical items such as: iPads, mobile phones, game consoles, music or video devices; as the centre cannot be responsible for the loss or damage of such items.
- There is a small gift shop which only sells small items so we ask that children do not bring any more than £5.00 spending money with them. Please ensure that your child's spending money is given to their class teacher in an envelope, clearly labelled with your child's name by Thursday 26th April 2018. We will not be able to take any money given after this date.

Medicine

- All medicines must be brought in to school by Wednesday 25th April
- Medicines must be clearly labeled with your child's name and dosage.
- If the medication is a daily medication (i.e. needs to be taken the night prior to the trip), please ensure it is brought into school on Monday morning (30th April) and handed to the adult in charge of medication.

Arrival and Leaving times.

- We will be leaving on a coach from the school at 9.30am and will be arriving at the centre at 10.00am.
- Please ensure that your child arrives at school by 9.00am. Bags must be left under the shelter in the playground, and children to proceed to the lower hall.
- Parents/Carers may wait under the shelter, if you wish to see the coach off.
- We will be leaving Wrotham on the return journey at 1.30pm to arrive back at school at between 2.00pm and 2.30pm. You can pick your child up at this time.

On Arrival

- On arrival at Wrotham, the children will be given a tour and shown to their rooms to unpack.
- They will then receive a pre-ordered packed lunch that the centre will provide before starting their first activity.
- Please ensure you have filled in the sandwich choice list before leaving the meeting today.

Activities:

- The children will begin their activities after lunch on Monday 30^{th} April and will complete their last activities on the morning of Wednesday 2^{nd} May before setting off for home.
- Children will have lunch before they leave the centre on Wednesday.
