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Homework:

- We will send out a homework grid at the beginning of each new topic. The children can choose an activity each week and hand it in every Wednesday, and it will be returned on Fridays.
- Children will also be issued weekly spelling homework which will be tested on Mondays and new spellings issued the same day.
- Reading: children should try to read for at least 10 minutes every night with an adult and record their progress in their reading journals.
 - Children should try to practise their times tables to gain fluency. In year three we focus on 3, 4 and 8 times tables.



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Times tables

As of 2018 children will now take a statutory times table test in year four. To help prepare them we will be completing weekly times tables tests in class. The children will start with bronze and when they get all of the questions correct they will move onto the next times table.

Children can take their tests home at the end of the sessions to help them practise for the following week.

These will be done on Fridays.
