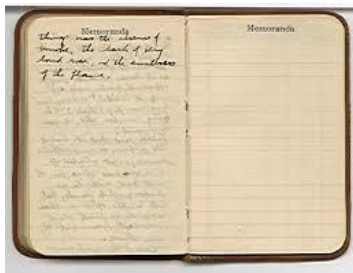


# Working Together Ideas
