1. In maths we have been learning about numbers - recognising and writing numerals, counting accurately and ordering numbers. To support this learning at home can you go on a number hunt? Look carefully for numbers that you find in your home (e.g. on the telephone, clock, microwave) or out and about (e.g. door numbers, bus numbers etc.). Can you name the numbers that you find? If you are feeling really clever you could have a go at recording some of the numbers that you find in your Learning Log.

At home this week can you try really hard to persevere at something you find tricky - may be putting on your school jumper or writing your name, riding your bike without stabilisers or doing up the zip on your coat.
