Learning Mentor Information for Parents/Carers

Hello!

I'm Montbelle's Learning Mentor and I work with children across the school to help provide a range of additional emotional support to pupils who may need it from time to time.

How I can help your child

I'm here to help your child overcome the social and emotional barriers that may get in the way of their learning and positive behaviours. I also provide a sympathetic ear for pupils during times of worry, or if they're experiencing difficulties.

Some examples of the types of things I may be able to help with are:

- Loss of motivation/difficulties in concentration.
- Disengaged from learning or social interactions.
- Low self-esteem and confidence.
- General unhappiness and low mood.
- Heightened levels of anxiety.
- Behavioural issues.
- Managing challenging emotions.
- Friendship issues and difficulties in building relationships.

For some children I deliver specific interventions to help support them which are either carried out in small groups, or on an individual basis in the Nurture Room. These are structured around specific needs and can be arranged for an agreed period of time.

Support during break times

Additionally, I provide support to children during break and lunch times, as these can be particularly vulnerable periods for some pupils. To help those who find lunch times a little challenging, I run a daily lunch club that provides an enjoyable alternative to the playground for those who need it.

Current lunch clubs include crafting, board games and fact-finding topics that help promote social interaction and build on teamworking skills, as well as provide a

comfortable environment in which to have a break. Children can choose which sessions they attend, however as spaces are limited, there may be a waiting list at times during high demand to ensure everyone gets a chance to come. Sessions run

I.00pm—I.30pm either on the Montbelle Bus or in the ICT suite.

How children are referred to me

Referrals for support from me can be made via the class teacher, professionals working with families and from parents/carers themselves.

If you'd like to discuss anything with me, I'm usually around the KS2 doors in the morning as the children come into school, or feel free to contact me via the school office.
